The Metropolitan Museum of Art offers two Leonard A. Lauder Fellowships in Modern Art (each for a two-year term) annually to scholars studying Cubism or a related topic. One position is intended for a predoctoral candidate who is embarking on his or her dissertation; the other fellowship is reserved for a qualified postdoctoral scholar at any stage of his or her career.

All Lauder Fellows are expected to contribute to the activities and programming of the Leonard A. Lauder Research Center for Modern Art. Fellows must be in residence at the Metropolitan Museum during the fellowship period, which takes place between September 1, 2016 and August 31, 2018. The stipend amount for one year is \$45,000 for predoctoral fellows and \$55,000 for post-doctoral fellows.
