Long-Term Fellowships

Deadline: November 15, 2015

Long-Term Fellowships are intended to support individual scholarly research and promote serious intellectual exchange through active participation in the Newberry's scholarly activities. Applicants must hold a PhD at the time of application in order to be eligible. Fellowships provide a stipend of \$4,200 per month. Short-Term Fellowships

Deadline: December 15, 2015

Short-Term Fellowships are available to postdoctoral scholars, PhD candidates, and those who hold other terminal degrees. Most fellowships are restricted to scholars who live and work outside the Chicago Metro area. Short-Term Fellowships are generally awarded for one continuous month in residence at the Newberry, with stipends of \$2,500 per month.
