The co-directors of the Getty "Connecting Art Histories" project SPANISH ITALY AND THE IBERIAN AMERICAS seek a current graduate student or recent PhD to serve as an adjunct staff associate. The project is to develop a new field of "Art History of the Iberian World," exploring connections between Spanish Italy and the Iberian Americas in the long sixteenth-century. It will involve a group of twenty scholars and will be structured around a trip to Italy and a week of meetings in NYC. The staff associate will be based in the NYC area, and will work on a part-time basis, approximately eight hours/week for approximately eighteen months (February, 2016 to August, 2017). Salary commensurate with experience. Responsibilities include the coordination of all group activities — travels, presentations, website, etc. Applications should be sent by email to Michael Cole and Alessandra Russo at connectingarthistories@columbia.edu. They should include a letter of interest (2 pages), a description of the applicant's work in the grant field(s) (2 pages), two letters of recommendation, and a CV. Application materials should be sent all together in pdf, clearly labeled. Fluency in Italian and/or Spanish preferred. Screening will begin November, 20th, 2015 and will continue until the position is filled.
