Applicants must submit name(s), email address and affiliation, as well as the title, abstract (max. 300 words) outlining a 20-minute paper along with a brief bio (max. 150 words) before 1 July to mariajoacastro@fcsh.unl.pt

All proposals will undergo a blind peer review system.

Authors are responsible for all image reproduction rights.

Working languages: Portuguese, French, Spanish or English. No translation will be provided.

The best papers will be published in e-book with open access and in a paper edition (with ISBN).

PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Word document, 12 pages maximum, space 1.5, lettering Time New Roman, footnotes and a final bibliography until six references.
