Humanitas is the oldest scholarly journal published in Portugal that is devoted to Greek, Latin, and Renaissance Classical Studies, although it welcomes contributions from other congruent fields of study (History, Archaeology, Philosophy, Religion, Art, Rhetoric, Reception of the Classics, among others).

Humanitas has been published regularly on a yearly basis since its inception in 1947, and is owned by the Institute of Classical Studies of the Faculty of Letters, University of Coimbra.

From 2017 onwards two issues will be published each year, with their call for submissions permanently open. Manuscripts and reviews are to be submitted online, via the Open Journal Systems (OJS) platform:

Authors should consult the Submission Guidelines prior to submitting any work on the OJS platform.

All items submitted are peer reviewed and evaluated by anonymous referees.

Submissions and reviews are published in the volume of the journal in preparation at the time at which the process of their evaluation and editing is concluded.

Humanitas is indexed by the Web of Science (Thomson Reuters/ESCI), Latindex, Dialnet, European Reference Index for the Humanities and Social Sciences (ERIH PLUS), Scientific Journal Impact Factor, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) and EBSCO.

The journal assigns a DOI (Digital Object Identifier) to all articles and reviews published.
