"Humanities News" will publish news and headlines in the following research areas: Archaeology & History, Art History & Cultural Studies, Philosophy & Theology, Literature & Linguistics, Anthropology & Social Sciences and New Humanities (Digital or Interdisciplinary Humanities). The news/headlines are not restricted to any particular epoch, society, medium or region. They can include notes to (new) projects, scientific trends, special events (exhibitions, seminars, conferences etc.), new articles, books, films, web sources etc. or special artefacts. Comments to the impact and future of the humanities are also welcome.

The teams (1 Editor and 2 Writers per area) will select and create a new micro-blog/tweet once a week (40-250 characters).
