As part of the DFG (German Research Foundation) Priority Programme, "Cultural Translation in the Early Modern Period," the project "Art and Crisis: Transnational and Interconfessional Translation Processes in Art and Architecture in Great Britain (1625-1727)" will be funded for a three-year period at the Institute for Art History of the Friedrich Alexander University of Erlangen-Nuremberg (FAU).
