The maximum stipend of \$42,000 per annum will be prorated for shorter terms. The Fellowship includes round-trip travel at U.S. government rates from the fellow's residence to Washington D.C. Research space, a networked computer, and access to art collections, archives, and Smithsonian Institution Libraries are provided.

This is a postdoctoral fellowship, open to scholars of all nationalities. The application deadline is December 15, 2011
