The role is dedicated to the development of the research environment for a SNSF-founded research project as well as the ongoing implementation of the public research portals of the gta Archives. It is the position involves the design and implementation of several research environments using semantic web technology. It also includes the implementation of custom ETL-processes, including analysis, cleaning, modelling, and transformation of cultural heritage data using common target ontologies (CIDOC-CRM, among others), as well as the harmonisation of these datasets across multiple partner projects. The position is limited to 3 years, with option for extension.

The ideal candidate should have an academic degree and preferably a multidisciplinary background embracing both humanities (art history, architecture, or alike) and/or information science (computer science, knowledge representation), and a proven track record in analysis, cleaning, modelling, and transformation of cultural heritage data. Practical working knowledge of CIDOC-CRM modelling, semantic technologies (RDF, RDFS, OWL, SPARQL), and web technologies (HTML, CSS) is essential. Basic knowledge in one or more programming languages is beneficial, but not mandatory. ^{III}
