### We offer:

- employment: 0.8 - 1.0 FTE;
- depending on your qualifications and level of experience, the gross monthly salary will be between € 5,541 (min. scale H2, starting scale) and € 7,921 (max. scale H2), based on a 38-hour working week;

- term of contract: five years, with the possibility of extension;
- classification in the Dutch university job-ranking system (UFO): Full Professor, Level 2;
