Once the theme and chair(s) of the panel are selected, this session will solicit contributors through CAA's open call. The chair or co-chairs must be members in good standing of AHNCA and CAA.

Submissions should include a CV and should be sent to Patricia Mainardi (pmmainardi@gmail.com), who will forward them to the committee. The deadline for consideration is April 1 with a decision announced by April 10 so that unsuccessful proposals can still be submitted directly to CAA before its deadline of April 30, 2019.
