General Requirements

Applicants should have a PhD in film and media studies. Expertise in creative/media industries and digital media will especially be welcome. The appointee, besides being an effective teacher, is expected to produce quality research in the very near future; she or he is required to participate in competitive grant exercises and to assist the Department with administration and curriculum development.
