New Histories of Art: Polish art of the 20th and 21st century

The collaborative series published jointly by the Museum of Modern Art in Warsaw and the Faculty of Management of Visual Culture of the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw introduces new research perspectives in the history of Polish art of the 20th and 21st century. The Advisory Board and the Editorial Staff would like to encourage authors to submit their book proposals. We are accepting standalone, original and completed manuscripts of research works either in Polish or English. Doctoral dissertations are welcome, but we would ask you first to adapt them to the requirements of book publication.

We guarantee an author's fee and covering the cost of publication. We are ranked among peer-reviewed publishers (80 pts). Books will be published both as physical copies and e-books. English language publications will be distributed internationally through the University of Chicago Press.
