The Bauhaus Legacy: Myth, Reality and Reevaluation Oct. 24- 27, 2002

The Bauhaus has become synonymous with the very idea of Modernity, possessing mythological status in the modern consciousness. Yet this myth often obscures the confrontational and fragmentary nature of its reality. >From its inception the Bauhaus sought to address the complex social, political and aesthetic issues of the day, in an attempt to unite art and life in the face of industrialization. The internal debates that ensued were often contentious and contradictory revealing the turbulent substructure of modernity. Contemporary criticism centers on a reevaluation of the basic tenets of modernism, and the Bauhaus lies symbolically at the heart of this reevaluation. This symposium seeks to address the programmatic and ideological debates that shaped the Bauhaus and explore their relationship to the Post- industrial condition and contemporary architectural education.
