provide teaching and research in the said area, covering the whole subject.

In line with article 100 of the Higher Education Act of the land of Berlin  
(Berliner Hochschulgesetz), a postdoctoral lecturing qualification

(Habilitation) or comparable qualifications for a teaching career in higher education are required.

The successful candidate will have widespread connections within international research networks. She or he is expected to have experience in securing external funding and in managing externally funded projects, as well as international experience in teaching and research.

The language of instruction will generally be German, but some activities may be offered in English. A non-German speaking appointee will be expected to be able to teach in German within two years.

The Freie Universität Berlin is an equal opportunities employer.

The successful candidate will be offered civil servant or public sector employee status (Professorial Grade W2 auf Zeit).
