Funds will be distributed in April 2006. The recipient(s) will be asked to write a short account of his/her project (s) for publication in the HNA Newsletter.

The application should consist of: (1) short description of project (1-2 pp); (2) budget; (3) list of further funds applied/received for the same project; (4) current c.v. A selection from a recent publication or (for students) a letter of recommendation may also be included.
