The conference will also include crossover sessions and social activity with the concurrent People of the River Conference hosted by Sto:lo Nation in Chilliwack.

Individual paper proposals should include an abstract (250 words maximum) and one page curriculum vitae. Panel proposals should include an overall description of the theme for the session, as well as abstracts for each of the papers and a curriculum vitae for each of the participants / commentators. Correspondence may be in either English or French. Proposals can be submitted electronically, by fax or by mail.

Subject to funding, efforts will be made to supply limited travel assistance to presenters. First priority for financial support will be given to students and unaffiliated scholars on a case by case basis.
