FIRST INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF THE EUROPEAN ARCHITECTURAL HISTORY NETWORK

The program for the EAHN First International Meeting in Guimarães, Portugal is now available. The four-day conference (17-20 June 2010) features twenty sessions and five roundtables, with over 150 speakers and session chairs coming from five continents and seventeen European countries, and subjects ranging from ancient, medieval and early modern architecture through nineteenth- and twentieth-century topics.

Keynote events will close each of the three days of proceedings, with the following keynote speakers: Paulo Varela Gomes (Coimbra), Denise Scott Brown (Philadelphia), Gülsüm Baydar (Izmir), and Antoine Picon (Harvard).

The final day of the conference offers two optional day-long regional tours. A number of shorter tours, meetings of EAHN Thematic Groups, an EAHN Plenary Session, and a meeting of the EAHN Committee are also included in the program.

The conference will be held at the Vila Flor Cultural Centre, Guimarães. Most categories of conference registration include conference abstracts and three dinners. The regular registration period ends on 30 April 2010; those registering on 1 May or after will be subject to the late registration fees. Special discounts are available for students and those attending from countries with emerging economies.
