In preparing the catalogue raisonné Franz Kline Paintings, 1950–1962, we are seeking information from our colleagues in the field about Franz Kline's oil-on-canvas works made between 1950 and the artist's death in 1962. The catalogue raisonné represents a unique opportunity to gather detailed information on every painting created during those years. 'Franz Kline Paintings, 1950–1962' will be a free resource for scholars, historians, museums, galleries, and others interested in the artist's work. It will be published using the online catalogue raisonné platform panOpticon.
