The following supporting material is required for each submission:

1. Nomination letter outlining the relevant achievements of the nominee(s)
2. CV(s) of nominee(s)
3. 2-4 letters of support for the nominee(s) explaining the significance of the work or body of work. Letters should be from fellow scholars familiar with the nominee(s)'s work.

Please do not submit self-nominations.

Nominations will be judged on the quality of research, originality, and clarity of writing, and usefulness of the work to the fields of art conservation, art history, and allied fields.
