Have an excellent record of achievement and publication in the field of visual arts; the record must demonstrate ongoing artistic practice and influence among experts in the field;

Demonstrate the ability to provide high-quality university teaching and student supervision, particularly in arts practice, art history, and research-creation;

Demonstrate the potential to develop internal, national, and international collaborations; Adequate proficiency in the French language or a strong commitment to mastering the proficiency level required upon assuming the position in accordance to Université de Montréal's Language Policy. A French language learning assistance program is offered to all professors who wish to acquire French language skills or enhance their communication abilities.
