We invite all those interested in participating to submit previously unpublished articles in Spanish, English, or Portuguese which present reflections on the history, theory and criticism of art. Articles submitted should not be undergoing other evaluation processes nor have publishing commitments with any other publication. Originals submitted for consideration must meet the journal's standards.

Article's parameters:

- Should be written in a Word format archive, Times New Roman size 12 font, double spacing, paginated, and letter size paper with margins of 2.5 cm.
- Should have an extension between 7.000 and 10.000 words in total, including abstracts, keywords, bibliography, and footnotes.
- A maximum of ten figures (e.g., pictures, graphics, illustrations, photographs, maps, and images) per article will be allowed; these are not part of the length of the article and the author must ensure that the rights of use are in order.
- H-ART uses the Chicago Manual of Style citation format, in its latest edition, version Notes and bibliography. The notes will be footnoted, Times New Roman 10 points and single-spaced.
- On the first page there should be an abstract in Spanish, of no more than 120 words, and its respective translation into English. The title of the text should be presented in both languages.
- There should be a list of four to six keywords that identify the article, both in Spanish and English.

Submission deadline: April 30, 2025.
