

Insert No. 8, 2026: Transforming the Anthropocene

The new issue #8 of INSERT. Artistic Practices as Cultural Inquiries, edited by Dorota Sajewska and Julia Schade, introduces the concept of the Anthro(s)cene as a critical reconfiguration of dominant Anthropocene discourse, which often re-essentialises a universalised figure of anthropos, thereby obscuring historical and ongoing forms of colonial dispossession and environmental injustice. Drawing on feminist, decolonial, and new materialist perspectives, the issue proposes a shift from subject-centred agency to relational, planetary configurations of action. By focusing on contemporary performative practices, the authors frame the Anthro(s)cene as a critical space for ontological openness, enabling alternative understandings of humanity beyond universalist and anthropocentric paradigms.
