The ability to convey complex ideas, in simple ways, to a wide range of audiences will be essential.

Key to success in these roles will be high levels of initiative, resilience and determination. Well-developed organisation, verbal and written communication skills and the ability to operate within an inter-disciplinary environment with a broad cross-section of colleagues will be an expectation of the role.
