The Terra Foundation for American Art International Essay Prize recognizes excellent scholarship by a non-U.S. scholar in the field of historical American art (circa 1500–1980). The aim of the award is to stimulate and actively support non-U.S. scholars working on American art topics, foster the international exchange of new ideas, and create a broad, culturally comparative dialogue on American art. The winning manuscript will advance understanding of American art, demonstrating new findings and original perspectives, and will be translated and published in *American Art*, the Smithsonian American Art Museum's scholarly journal, which covers the cost of image rights and reproduction.

The winner receives a \$1,000 cash award and a travel stipend of up to \$3,000 to give a presentation in Washington, D.C.
